

Virtual Summit FAQ

HOW DO I ATTEND THE SUMMIT?

You can attend as many or as few sessions as you like! Although sessions within each track are complementary, they are all stand-alone sessions with unique content. You can register for each session individually at nffty.org/summit-2021.

WHY DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

When you register for a session, you will receive an email confirmation with an access code, which you will need in order to join. Plus, you'll get the option to add the event to your calendar, reminder emails, all that good stuff!

ARE SESSIONS LIMITED IN CAPACITY?

Yes, space is limited in each session, and registering in advance ensures that you will be able to actively participate as each session permits (Q&A with the presenters, for example).

WHERE DO I FIND THE REGISTRATION LINKS?

All sessions are listed on the corresponding Track page, and each session has a unique registration link attached to it. You can also register for most sessions using the REGISTER NOW button at the top of the main summit page.

WHAT DO I NEED IN ORDER TO ACCESS THE SESSIONS?

Most of the sessions are hosted as webinars or meeting on Zoom, with a few special events taking place on the Airmeet platform. To access, you will need a strong internet connection, a laptop or desktop computer, and a functional browser (Chrome is required for Airmeet). For most of the webinars, your participation as an audience member will be through chat and Q&A functions, and so you do not need to have your video and audio turned on. To participate in interactive sessions and our Career & Education Fair, a working camera and audio mic are essential.

WHAT IF A SESSION I WANT TO ATTEND IS FULL?

If a session reaches capacity, we will be livestreaming it on our YouTube page. Additionally, sessions will be made available on YouTube after the live event, so even if you miss something you will be able to access the content at a future date.
